Bottom Lines

In accordance with School District Policy and the Criminal Code the following behaviours will not be tolerated at Millstream Elementary.

- physical and/or verbal abuse (purposely trying to hurt someone)
- possession or use of weapons
- swearing at a staff member
- threats and/or intimidation (kill you, break your neck...)
- harassment/abuse of a racial, sexist or ableist nature.

It is each student's responsibility to follow the guidelines and expectations of our code of conduct so that we can learn and play in a safe and caring school community. *Hurting another student in 'self-defense' is not OK. Students have other options to deal with problems.*

When a student's action(s) demonstrate non-compliance with our school code of conduct careful consideration of appropriate consequences will occur once the details of the incident have been fully determined.

Depending upon the severity and/or frequency of the inappropriate conduct one or more of the following may occur:

- recording of the incident.
- contact with parents/caregivers.
- restitution to individuals involved.
- verbal or written apology.
- performing a school community service.
- establishing a 'my job is, my job is not' contract.
- loss of playground time.
- in-school or out-of-school suspension.
- referral to the School Based Team.
- withdrawal from school activities, eg. field trips, extra-curricular activities.
- reimbursement if property loss or damage is involved.
- referral to school counsellor.
- actions directed under District Policy.
