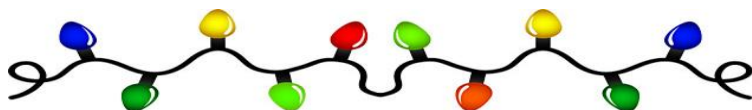
Help Fill the Hampers!
