# **Traffic Safety**

We are continuing to ask families to **PLEASE respect the need for traffic safety** during afternoon pick-up time. Do **NOT park in the pull-through** area in front of the school. This is meant for **VERY quick pull-in**, **pick-up and leave** to make space for the next family. If you arrive to the front of the line and your child is not there, you will be asked to loop the block and come back. We will **NOT** be able to accommodate parked cars for any length of time. If you are unable to drive into the pull-through, you **MUST drive around the block and try again.** You **CANNOT stop in the road** blocking traffic from flowing. The congestion that is caused by cars parking in the pull-through, stopping in the road and waiting for extended periods of time is dangerous and also delays our buses who need to be able to drive past the school to pick up their students and stay on their bus route time schedule. Please expect to see increased adult support outside including police presence. It is the **RESPONSIBILITY of ALL of us to keep your children SAFE!!!!!**
